BEVERLY HILLS: THE FOUR SEASONS

If Ian Schrager is involved, you can feel confident about the results. The consummate hotelier is behind The Residences at The West Hollywood EDITION, alongside architect John Pawson. Their vision for the residences above the hotel is the aesthetic equivalent of a cleansing breath: seamless white oak floors, bronze-hued louvered screens, Molteni kitchens

PACIFIC PALISADES: ONE COAST For the barefoot dinner set, One Coast delivers a SoCal dream. The new oceanfront residential project in the Pacific Palisades has sea views galore and offers up 53 townhomes and single-level flats with up to 5,017 square feet of living space. PASADENA: 388 CORDOVA Pasadena's

foray into the high-rise scene is an impressive one: 388 Cordova is the first luxury offering in the family-friendly city, with 105 new units boasting bragworthy views of L.A.
